### Please note the following important information before signing this form:

- The trips and activities covered by this consent include:
  - ~ all visits (including residential trips) which take place during the holidays or a weekend in the UK
  - ~ adventure activities at any time
  - ~ off-site sporting fixtures outside the school day.
- The school will send you information about each trip or activity before it takes place.
- PE staff will advise students of sporting fixtures: fixture information is also available to school team members on the school's website under Parents and Carers/Sports & Fixtures/Sports & Fixtures.
- You can, if you wish, tell the school that you do not want your child to take part in any particular school trip or activity.

Should an activity require a higher level of risk management, and for all overseas trips, we would require separate, written consent.

### Medical Information

We will use the medical information that you have given to the school via the Data Collection Sheet and which is kept on the school's information management system to assess what medication is needed during visits. Therefore, it is very important that this information is accurate and up-to-date. If there are any changes to your child's medical condition, you must let the school know immediately.

### Payment for Trips

Requests for payment for trips will be sent by letter and must be paid for via ParentPay which is a quick and secure way to pay for school trips. You will be given ParentPay log on information at the start of the Autumn term.
