Year 10 Face-to-Face Support and Teaching

We are very excited to welcome your son back into Beths next week albeit in a limited capacity in line with government guidelines. We are keen to help plug some of the gaps created by the extended period of home learning and also deepen understanding of content which has already been initially understood. We also believe that it is important for our Year 10 students to take their first step in returning to a more normal educational experience. In order to make the school Covid-Secure we will be operating in a very different manner to normal so please can you read through the attached student Guide and then ensure your son reads all sections. Please let us know if there is any further information which you need after reading the guide or require any additional safeguards for your son in order for him to take advantage of this provision.
