




YEAR 7 ENGLISH

It is an internationally recognised exam that will benefit my future career endeavours. Helpful websites include quizlet.com and chineseinflow.com which both really helped me pass.

HSK is a Chinese mandarin proficiency test in which people from around the world partake in. It is taken to either comply with the requirements for admission to a Chinese university; to obtain a proficiency certificate for employment or career advancement or to simply test their level of Chinese proficiency. After passing the HSK 3 test, I see why it was so beneficial for me and how it can aid me in my future career of becoming a doctor. Websites such as https://www.chineseinflow.com/ that Ms Li introduced it to us acted as strong pillars for my Mandarin Chinese knowledge by providing all the potential words found in the exam which were easy to understand and digest. We also received support sessions from teachers which involved completing multiple past papers and hard practice, which allowed me to obtain a gold certificate in my HSK exam. The Mandarin Excellence Programme teachers at Beths also helped fund our HSK, which acted as a reward for my hard work and determination.

During KS3 Chinese Experience Club today, the students made their own Chinese firecrackers.




YEAR 9 MERIT STUDENTS




MUSICIAN OF THE WEEK
