MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents, Carers,



We welcome you to our first VIP of the new academic year. This week we saw the whole school return, with our new Year 7s and Year 12s having days the previous week for settling in. A new start to our year and we are encouraging the terminology of our students being Beths Scholars. Over the coming term, the expectations will be embedded with our Scholars and I'm sure you will hear more about this from your son/daughter. Our Scholars

have been given their own school lanyards to sign in and out of school with. And these are expected to be part of their school uniform. There are a number of sign-in/out points placed in and outside of the main school reception, as well as in the student reception for them to use. This helps us identify which students are onsite before and after the school day and it is compulsory for all to wear their lanyards.

On Thursday we held an Awards Presentation Evening for the last academic year, celebrating the achievement across all year groups. It will be a poignant evening in our memory, as I had to break the celebrations to announce the passing of Her Majesty the Queen.

The school photographer was in school on Friday taking photos of Years 7, 9, 10 and 12. These will be used to update our school systems.

Next week we will be hosting the Bexley 11+ test for the Local Authority, over three days; Tuesday 13th, Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th September 2022. In order to accommodate a large number of students sitting the test at our school, we are having to put three-year groups on remote learning.

Lessons will be live and as per the normal timetable.

Looking ahead this term, we will be hosting our Welcome afternoon to Year 7 and Year 12 parents on Thursday 22nd September and Thursday 29th September respectively from 18:00-19:00, more information will be sent out shortly. Our Year 6 open events will also commence from Monday 26th September where an online booking system has been set up to accommodate families who wish to visit the school.








HAPPY TEACHER'S DAY


