So why should this be celebrated?

In the UK just over half of black students experienced name calling or uncomfortable questions about their hair at school, and a recent survey showed that 46% of parents say their children's school uniform policy penalizes afro hair.

The way you style afro-textured hair sometimes depends on the texture of the hair itself - it can't always be styled in the same ways that straight hair often is.

Some of the ways afro-textured hair is styled may also be against the rules in some schools and therefore it is up to us as members of the black or mixed-race community to stand up against such discrimination.

What is being done?

In the UK there is an act in place called 'The Halo Code' which guarantees black people in both schools and workplaces freedom and security to wear their hair as they want without any boundaries and discrimination. Dating back to slavery, afro hair has been controlled over and scrutinized to conform to the Western standards. Who decided cornrows are 'unprofessional' at interviews? As a community at Beths, it's important that we let members of the afro community know that all hair is to be welcomed and encouraged. Not for us to feel restrictions on how we may style our OWN hair.


