






SCIENCE WEEK

During the week of 10th - 19th March, we will be celebrating Science Week. There will be a range of activities put on by the science department for all year groups, including a KS3 poster design competition.



STEM CLUB

This term during STEM Club students are participating in a course called "survival in a desert island". This is an 8-week long project filled with of different activities enabling them to enter for a crest certificate at the end.







STEM CLUB

Students wrote a secret message and used heat to reveal it. Doing this allowed them to explore how heat can decompose a substance, changing its colour and making it visible. Students used natural resources to write the secret message, many naturally occurring substances don't have pigment, but if they change the substance by heating it, colour can be achieved.
