Year 12 Trial Exam topics

The Year 12 trial examination period begins on the 22nd of April. The teacher predicted grade will predominantly be based on the Year 12 trial exams, however other assessment data may also be considered. Attached is information about the topics your child should be revising for their exams. We hope that by providing this information now, your child will have ample time to prepare and therefore they can showcase their potential in the Year 12 trial exams.

Regardless of the subject we recommend that your child:

- Plans their independent study, they have access to empty study timetables. Five hours per subject, per week of independent study is recommended.
- Transforms learnt content into a different format, for example mind maps, summarised notes or flashcards.
- Retrieves information from memory (active recall), this can be done using several different strategies including completing exam questions, completing quizzes, using flashcards, and/or writing what they remember about a topic and then using resources to develop their understanding of content they had forgotten, sometimes referred to as 'blurting.'

Resources for students are available on Microsoft Teams alongside their textbooks and lesson notes.
